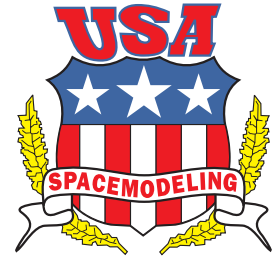
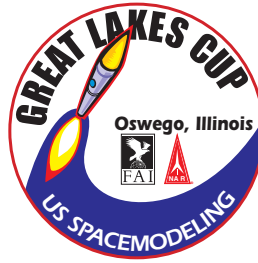

- Organizer** Illinois Society of Amateur Rocketry (ISAR #696) and the National Association of Rocketry.
- Date/Place** 23-24 June 2012, Oswego, ILL, USA

- Rules compliance** NAR Sporting Code, <http://www.nar.org/pinkbook/>. Only contest-approved rocket motors as certified by the NAR allowed in contest. Listed at <http://www.nar.org/SandT/NARenglist.shtml>.
- Contest site** Oswego East High School, 1525 Harvey Road in Oswego, ILL.
- Categories** S4A, S6A, S8E/P, S9A- World Cup;
S1B, S3A- Non World Cup- Open International.
- Participants** Competition is open for all members of FAI NAC having valid FAI sporting license.
- Contest rules** FAI Sporting Code effective since January 1ST, 2011. In class S1B altitude will be measured by electronic altimeters in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code, Section 4, Volume Space Models, paragraph 4.9.2.1. All flights shall be measured with the competitor-supplied electronic altimeter ADREL (Poland) ALT-USB.
- FAI Jury** To be announced.
- Official languages** English.
- Currency** US Dollars (USD).
- Awards** Diplomas and medals will be awarded for top three places in the each category.
- Entry fee** The participation fee for the contest is \$20 USD, to be paid at registration.
- Protest** According to FAI Sporting Code with a deposit of \$20 USD.
